## Linux

### SUSE 10.1 for 8.6.0 Basic Installation

When running SUSE 10.1 please use the following cpio command:

```
cpio -ivBmud --absolute-filenames </dev/mnt/tsi_env
```

The `usr/lib/basic` directory will be created and `./install -n` will run correctly. Otherwise you will receive the following error message.

```
Basic installation corrupt ....  
Please reload from media.  
System error -1  
suse10:/usr/860bas #
```
